Because a Works Cited list is organized alphabetically, the books by the same author will appear next to one another. When this occurs, the author's name should be omitted in the second citation. Instead of the author's name, include three hyphens and a period and then the remainder of the citation information. For example: Crystal, David.

How to Cite Two Different Books by the Same Author in MLA ...

If so, then you need to treat each chapter as an individual piece of information and create an individual citation for each. Follow the form for Chapter from an Edited Book. Since you will have multiple citations with the same authors & dates, you can differentiate them with a letter system, i.e. White, T., & Aussie, R. T. (2014a).

Citing multiple works by same author References by the same author (or by the same group of authors in the same order) are arranged by year of publication in the Reference list, with the earliest first. For references with the same author and year, the references are arranged alphabetically by title (ignoring "A" or "The").

Multiple works by the same author - APA 6th Edition ...

Two or More Books by the Same Author. List works alphabetically by title. (Remember to ignore articles like A, An, and The.) Provide the author's name in last name, first name format for the first entry only. For each subsequent entry by the same author, use three hyphens and a period.

Citing Works With the Same Author and Date. . When multiple references have an identical author (or authors) and publication year, include a lowercase letter after the year. These letters are assigned when the references are placed in order in the reference list (alphabetically by title, following the guidelines in Section 9.47). The year-letter combination is used in both the in-text citation and the reference list entry.

Citing Works With the Same Author and Date

Citing a single author who wrote multiple works requires differentiating the sources by the date or by the addition of a letter with the date for works written in the same year. References Page Format. When determining the order of entries on the references list when one author has multiple works, place the oldest publication first.

But if you were planning to title your thriller The Da Vinci Code—a specific title associated with a bestselling series—you'd better make other arrangements.

Can You Use the Same Book Title That's Been Used Before ...

Use this format when a person other than the original author has added a new part to the work, such as a foreword or introduction. Provide the author of the whole book in the main author element of the reference. Then provide the name of the person who wrote the foreword, introduction, or other new part, in parentheses, after the word "with."
