3 This Cargo Securing Manual specifies arrangements and cargo securing devices provided on board the ship for the correct application to and the securing of cargo units, containers, vehicles and other entities, based on transverse, longitudinal and vertical forces which may arise during adverse weather and sea conditions.

Points to ponder for cargo securing manual : "Cargo Securing Devices" is all fixed and portable devices used to secure and support cargo units. "Maximum Securing Load" (MSL) is a term used to define the allowable load capacity for a device used to secure cargo to a ship. "Safe Working Load" (SWL) may be substituted for MSL for securing purposes, provided this is equal to or exceeds the strength defined by MSL.

Cargo Securing Manual (CSM) The manual required on all types of ships engaged in the carriage of all cargoes other than solid and liquid bulk cargoes. Cargo units, including containers, shall be loaded, stowed and secured throughout the voyage in accordance with Cargo Securing Manual approved by the Administration.

1.6.2 The cargo securing arrangements detailed in the ships Cargo Securing Manual, if provided, should be based on the forces expected to affect the cargo carried by the ship, calculated in accordance with the method described in annex 13 or with a method accepted by the Administration or approved by a classification society acceptable to the Administration.

CODE OF SAFE PRACTICE FOR CARGO STOWAGE AND SECURING

The container stowage plan developed by the shore planners did not comply with the instructions and guidance contained in the ship's cargo securing manual.. The weights of the containers' allocated slots in bay 70 (where the collapse occurred) did not match or resemble the weight distribution patterns provided in the CSM..
