An independent clause expresses a complete thought and can stand by itself as a complete sentence. A dependent clause, or subordinate clause, contains a subject and a verb but cannot stand alone as a sentence. A subordinate clause must always be combined with an independent clause.

There are two types of clause: An independent clause (one that can stand alone as a sentence). A dependent clause (one that is usually a supporting part of a sentence). In these three quotations, the independent clauses are shown in bold and the dependent clauses aren't.

Such a phrase is called Main or Independent clause. On the other hand, the second clause 'who was crying' does not give a complete meaning and cannot (as alone) stand as a complete sentence. It depends on the main clause to give a complete meaning. Such a clause is called Subordinate or Dependent clause.

An independent clause functions on its own to make a meaningful sentence and looks much like a regular sentence.
